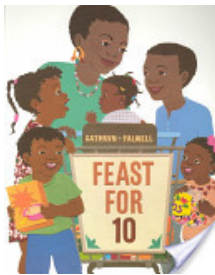




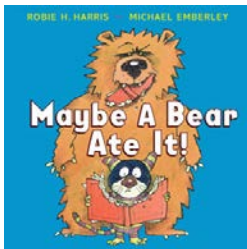
Cast your vote for the 2012 *Preschool One Book, One Denver* selection!
